

Weather Worms

- **ACTIVITY 1 – Weather Worms**

The weather can change rapidly in just 24 hours, hence the expression “4 Seasons in one day”. It can be random and unpredictable. These Weather worms are a fun activity and make light of the changing weather conditions to which we are often exposed.

Obtain 3 different coloured balls of wool

Cut about 12 pieces of wool in each of three different colours
(About 50cm long is about right)

Thread each group of through a metal loop to the half way point along the strands and plait the three colours together.

Print out the following text or have the Girls write it out. (Preferable to laminate if possible)

CONGRATULATIONS

You are now the proud owner of a

WEATHER WORM!

Please hang it outside your window

If it is **wet**, it is **raining**

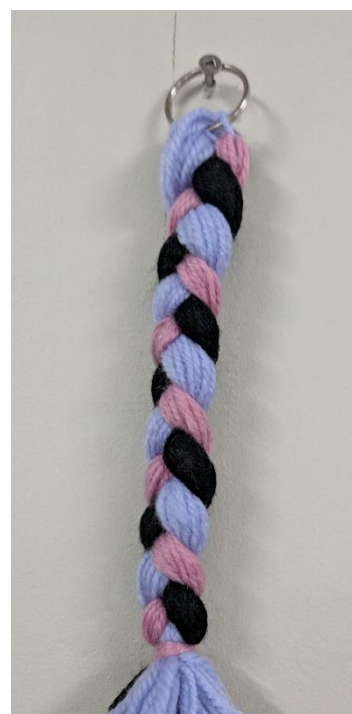
If it is **stiff**, it is **freezing**

If you **can't see it**, it is **foggy**

If it is **white**, it is **snowing**

If it is **moving**, it is **windy**

If it has **gone**, it has been **stolen**



- **ACTIVITY 2 – Pictionary Play Dough**

Give each group a tub of play dough and then invite one member from each patrol to come up to the leader to find out the object they need to make. For this session, each item they had to make had a weather theme. (eg. umbrella, gum boot, rain drop, snowflake, snowman). The first group to guess the object wins.
