

Draw Like Me Activity

Girls should be pairs for this activity.

One of the pair are given a picture which they must not show to anyone else.

The girls should sit with their backs to each other.

The girl with the picture must describe to her partner how to draw what she sees.

The girl who is drawing is permitted to ask questions.

Discussion:

Why don't many of the pictures look like the same?

(Interpretation: everyone has a different interpretation, directions maybe not clear, details missing, assumptions made about what has been said).

Would it help to be able to watch the person drawing? (Interpretation: It always helps to have a task demonstrated rather than just verbally explained).
