

Type of beak shape	Food type	Bird
Straw	Juice	Nectar feeding e.g Hummingbird. A <u>straw</u> like beak is perfect for drinking nectar...or <i>juice</i> . They are long and slender.
Scissors	Marshmallows	Bird of Prey (raptorial) The <u>scissors</u> can tear and rip the marshmallows like eagles do with meat.
Chopsticks	Wool worms	(Insect catching) The <u>chopsticks</u> can dig bits of wool out the ground just like insect eating birds digging worms out of the ground.
Tweezers	Coloured grains of rice	Chiselling bird e.g Woodpecker (insect eating). Thin, pointed bills. The <u>tweezers</u> can pry individual coloured grains of rice out of a bowl of rice like woodpeckers pry insects out of dead trees.
Forceps	Cherrios	Seed eating bird. E.g sparrow. The <u>forceps</u> can crack the cherrios open like the powerful beak of seed eating bird cracking open nuts and seeds.
Strainer	Marbles	Dip netting birds e.g pelicans. have long flat bills that <u>strain</u> small plants and animals from the water
