#### **NATURE SESSION**

Nature is the study of living plants and animals, and the natural environment which includes the weather and wilderness—eg. wild animals, rocks, forest

Make a nature bracelet by taping a piece of masking tape around your wrist. Walk around in a park and add different natural objects to your bracelet.

Eg. sticks, leaves, flowers, feathers etc.
